Loonshots: How to Nurture the Crazy Ideas That Win Wars, Cure Diseases, and Transform Industries

Drawing on the science of phase transitions, Safi Bahcall shows why teams, companies, or any group with a mission will suddenly change from embracing wild new ideas to rigidly rejecting them, just as flowing water will suddenly change into brittle ice.

Using examples that range from the spread of fires in forests to the hunt for terrorists online, and stories of thieves and geniuses and kings, Safi Bahcall helps us understand the behavior of companies and the fate of empires. Loonshots distills these insights into lessons for corporate innovators.

How To Create A Movement To Drive Transformation In Your Company Or Industry

Everybody has something they'd like to change, whether it is a problem in their organization, their industry, their community or society at large. But how can you get your ideas for change to take hold beyond a small circle of likeminded people?

What you need is a cascade: small groups that are loosely connected but united by a common purpose. When they synchronize their collective behavior as networks, they become immensely powerful. A business model is disrupted, an industry is remade, the preceding order is no more and the world is transformed.

Innovation Under Fire

Many companies across traditional industries are facing not just disruption, but downright extinction. And for many, Innovation – i.e., growth into adjacent and new markets, offerings new products and services, and new business models – is the only way out.

Ironically, these are also the companies that can least afford the luxury of formal innovation training, innovation labs, and other trappings of more stable firms.

But there is a solution – building and using innovation skills and capabilities in real time, while also executing survival-critical business
